She won the Newbery-Medal for *Walk Two Moons* and is a Newbery Honor winning author of *The Wanderer*. Her other works include *Bloomability*, *Absolutely Normal Chaos*, *Chasing Redbird*, *Pleasing the Ghost*, *Love That Dog*, and *Ruby Holler*. She was the first American winner of the Carnegie Medal for British children's books and the first person to win both the American Newbery Medal and the British Carnegie. The Club is open to ALL 3rd - 5th grade students...public, private, and homeschool. Parents and reading coaches are welcome to join in!
